We are delighted to announce that Beijing International Model United Nations 2019 (BIMUN 2019) with the theme of 'Young Partners for a Bright Future' (青年携手，大道同行) hosted by China Foreign Affairs University (CFAU) is going to be convened at CFAU (Shahe Campus) from 23 to 26 May, 2019.

Beijing International Model United Nations is the most recognized and well-known Model United Nations(MUN) conference in China. Every year, BIMUN receives whole-hearted support from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of People's Republic of China, Ministry of Education of People's Republic of China, the Central Committee of the Communist Youth League of China, the United Nations Association of China, the United Nations System in China and so on. It serves as a unique platform for students to deepen their understandings of international relations and the workings of the United Nations. As the vanguard that first introduced MUN activities to China, CFAU has a grand MUN history. BIMUN hosted annually by China Foreign Affairs University marks the highest MUN academic standard in China as well as a top flagship conference in Asia.

Introduction to the Committee and Topics:

As one of the six main organs of the United Nations, the United Nations Economic and Social Council has been at the heart of the United Nations system to advance the three dimensions of sustainable development – economic, social and environmental ever since 1945.

With the acceleration of urbanization, traditional vehicles, as an important means of transportation, face potential environmental and energy crisis. Meanwhile, hydrogen is a clean, efficient, safe and sustainable energy source and is believed to be the most potential alternative in the 21st century. However, there are still plenty of challenges for the promotion of hydrogen society, especially in terms of technology. Besides, the development of the hydrogen society is closely related to the development of housing and community. It is of crucial importance to upgrade the existing housing with regards to the needs of urban expansion, and provide systematic assistance for future community planning to improve the quality of public spaces. Through promoting hydrogen society and the sustainable development of cities and communities, we will help promote the 2030 sustainable development agenda and contribute to the achievement of 17 sustainable development goals.

Introduction to the Committee and Topics:

With the rapid growth in demand and consumption of plastics, large amounts of plastic debris enter the ocean every year from both land- and sea-based activities, such as fisheries and tourism, and poor waste management. This poses a huge threat to the plants and animals, including human beings as well. In addition, the fishery and tourism industries in many coastal and island countries are economically affected by the presence of plastic debris. Growing on the land-ocean boundary zone, mangrove forests are protecting the coast under harsh conditions with their complex biological structure. Unfortunately, mangroves in intertidal zones are disappearing from our planet at an appalling rate, thus exerting an enormous impact on the environment and human livelihoods. The marine plastic pollution and the destruction of mangrove ecosystems pose a series of formidable challenges for the ecological environment and international cooperative governance. Reducing plastic pollution in the oceans and its knock-on effects, and protecting mangrove ecosystems ensure sustainable consumption and production patterns, while protecting and promoting the sustainable use of territorial and marine ecosystem and resource. In turn, we can bring health and well-being to all.

Introduction to the Committee and Topics:

Cultural heritages, regarded as the conduits to achieve cultural diversity worldwide with inter-cultural communication, are of vital significance. Not only could they document the transformation of human societies, but also kindle human ingenuity and creativity. Nevertheless, cultural heritages are still subject to natural disasters, armed conflicts, looting and illicit trafficking.

The developing world, in particular, are more plagued with these challenges. As the local government lacks sufficient technical and financial support to provide personnel training and regular maintenance, the situation has become unprecedentedly severe.

Having recognized the urgency of these problems, the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) has been also devoted to strengthening the management of cultural heritage in South American countries under the South-South Cooperation. More significantly, the Centers for South-South Cooperation of UNESCO, specializing in providing scientific guidance on policymaking, will further the implementation of cultural heritage protection in developing countries.

Meanwhile, cultural artifacts which are prone to external threats also deserve attention from the international community. As the most internationally authoritative catalogue of cultural property protection, the World Heritage List is in action to prevent the priceless cultural artifacts from destruction.

Introduction to the Committee and Topics:

United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC) was established in 1997 by combining the United Nations Drug Control Programme and the Centre for International Crime Prevention together. UNODC is mandated to help all the Member States to fight against illicit drug problems, transnational crime, and international terrorism.

In order to respond to the Sustainable Development Goals 4 and 16, UNODC of Beijing International Model United Nations 2019 is going to discuss the problem of the rule of law and to combat crime. Education for Justice (E4J) initiative is started by UNODC and the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization, based on the intention to promote the rule of law through Global Citizenship Education. Meanwhile, according to the latest data published by the Afghanistan Opium Survey, the regional situation of illicit trafficking is still extremely severe. Delegates are expected to propose more practical suggestions and solutions during the discussion of two topics and understand better the whole procedure of combating crime.

委员会与议题介绍：

在全球化的时代背景下，全球卫生治理体系正在经历调整与变革。其中，作为与社区、家庭息息相关的基本一环，初级卫生保健领域的改革十分迫切。这一领域同样面临新的挑战：老年人口的增多、不合理的城市发展和气候问题加剧了传染病的传播；各国的初级卫生保健状况也良莠不齐；社会弱势群体的基本卫生需求仍难以得到保障。

在广大发展中国家，传统医学手段以其低成本、易获取的优势得到了广泛应用，而如何安全合理地将传统医学纳入主流卫生保健一直颇有争议。2019 年，传统医学将首次被纳入全球医学纲要，新一轮“新旧”碰撞或将上演。

从《阿拉木图宣言》中所倡导的“社会公正和人人享有更加健康的权利”，再到联合国可持续发展目标 3 的“良好健康与福祉”，促进全民健康、实现卫生公平一直是世界卫生组织努力的方向。如何满足日益增长的初级卫生保健需求，应对新的卫生挑战，传统医学与现代医学又是否能并蒂开花，世界卫生组织期待各位的到来。

## 危机联动委员会

### Joint Crisis Committee

议题：2000 年东非局势

工作语文：中文

代表制：混合代表制（共 50 名代表）

议事规则：北京议事规则（危机导向型）

委员会与议题介绍：

经过三十年的独立战争，厄立特里亚从埃塞俄比亚获得独立，并且于 1993 年获准进入联合国，其独立国家地位被国际社会承认。然而，非洲之角的战火并没有因此熄灭。1998 年 5 月，围绕着领土纠纷，战争再度在这两个最不发达国家之间爆发。大量资金被战争机器挥霍，无数村庄被毁，生灵惨遭涂炭。水深火热中的东非之角无不渴望和平与正义，无不渴求强大机构能够终结这场冲突。

在本次会议中，我们将聚焦 2000 年的东非局势，试图通过代表的角色扮演还原并平息这场冲突。在会议中，各国代表将致力于实现国家意志，两国将尝试在博弈中谋求本国的最佳利益组合，联合国安理会也将发挥其核心作用，汇集全球智慧，为地区冲突提供尽可能完善的解决方案。



## Organisation des Nations Unies pour l'alimentation et l'agriculture

Thème : Le développement de l'agriculture urbaine

Introduction :

A la suite du développement de l'urbanisation, de plus en plus de gens se déplacent de la région rurale à la ville, de plus en plus de gens habitent dans de grands immeubles. Mais on a de moins en moins de contacts avec la nature. L'agriculture, c'est la base de l'existence et du développement humains. Cependant, à cause de l'hémorragie démographique dans des zones rurales, le main-d'œuvre de l'agriculture traditionnelle se diminue. En même temps, La croissance rapide des villes dans le monde apporte une grande pression sur les systèmes d'approvisionnement alimentaires urbains. L'agriculture urbaine donne un nouveau plan au développement urbain. Elle est capable non seulement de satisfaire les besoins alimentaires urbains, mais aussi de créer des emplois et d'embellir la ville. Cela permet de rendre la ville et la nature plus étroites. Elle favorise aussi « la ville verte » et « le développement vert » que l'on préconise aujourd'hui.

Pourtant, son développement se heurte encore à des problèmes comme la mesure, la technique et la pollution dans certains pays et régions. Par cette réunion, le bureau espère que les délégués peuvent proposer des idées originales, et discuter ensemble la perspective du développement de l'agriculture urbaine, pour que la FAO puisse jouer pleinement son rôle.

Introduction :

L'Organisation internationale du Travail (OIT) a été fondée en 1919 selon le Traité de Versailles afin de promouvoir la paix et la stabilité sociale. Elle est devenue une institution spécialisée du système des Nations Unies en 1946. Aujourd'hui, sous le slogan « Promouvoir l'emploi, protéger les personnes », L'OIT se dévoue à améliorer les conditions d'économie à l'échelle mondiale et à réaliser l'objectif du travail décent pour tous, chez les femmes et les hommes.

Ces dernières années, les influences du réchauffement climatique deviennent de plus en plus importantes. Visant aux défis sévères causés par les changements climatiques, c'est le consensus de tout être humain de perfectionner le modèle économique actuel et de favoriser le développement durable. Dans ce contexte, une évolution considérable est en cours dans le monde de l'emploi. Le développement du travail vert, qui joue un rôle important d'équilibrer la protection de l'environnement et la croissance d'économie, revitalise aussi le développement du travail à l'avenir. Dans cette conférence, on va mettre accent sur les emplois verts, étudier des problèmes et des défis possibles dans le processus de transition professionnelle et essayer de trouver des solutions concrètes et pratiques pour favoriser l'économie verte et le travail décent en vue de contribuer à la réalisation des Objectifs de développement durable des Nations Unies.

## Organización Internacional para las Migraciones

Tema: Retorno Voluntario Asistido y Reintegración en América Latina

Lengua de trabajo: Español

Delegación: Delegado Simple (30 asientos)

Guía del Reglamento: Guía del Reglamento de Beijing (Moción-orientado)

La Organización Internacional para las Migraciones (OIM) se convirtió en el organismo de Naciones Unidas en 2016. Cuenta con 172 Estados Miembros. Hay 8 Estados que gozan del estatuto de observador.

En la segunda mitad del siglo XX, el tema de la migración en América Latina se fue tornando cada vez más notable. El problema de la migración se ha vuelto cada vez más grave. Ha tenido un impacto multifacético en el proceso de desarrollo social de los países latinoamericanos. El retorno de los migrantes que no desean o no pueden permanecer en el país de acogida o en el país de tránsito ya ha atraído la atención de todos los países.

La OIM de BIMUN 2019 se dedicará a realizar programas que faciliten el retorno voluntario y la reintegración de desplazados, migrantes y otras personas que requieran servicios internacionales de migración, teniendo debidamente en cuenta las necesidades y preocupaciones de las comunidades locales de América Latina. Sobre la base de respetar la dignidad de los migrantes, nos empeñamos en elaborar relativos proyectos a través de negociaciones, ayudar a encarar los crecientes desafíos que plantea la gestión de la migración a nivel operativo con el fin de promover la autosuficiencia y contribuciones a las comunidades de migrantes y de esa manera contribuir al desarrollo económico y social de los Estados.

## Main Press Centre

Working Language: Multilingual (English, Chinese, French and Spanish)

Representation: Press Delegation (30 delegates in total)

Introduction to the Committee:

The Main Press Centre (MPC) is a news reporting organ composed of major worldwide news media groups. Delegates will participate in meetings with fact-based reports in different forms. Journalists are expected to shoulder the responsibility of transmitting up-to-date facts and to some extent, influence the process of the conference. In BIMUN2019, MPC will introduce Press Agency Delegation as its delegation rule. Under different circumstances, press agencies should take up related duties with both challenges and fun. Journalists are not bound to have an impact on the countries in their assigned committees. Rather, they will learn skills of news production and strive to influence the public. MPC is dedicated to enlarging its influence, with the support of an in-time release platform. Moreover, traditional paper media will be invited to recall the dignity and solemnity of journalism, while maintaining its immediacy and efficiency.

- **The Invitation List and Application Procedures**

Beijing International Model United Nations is invitation-based and invites the most excellent MUN participants at home and abroad. This year, a total of 167 schools, institutes, MUN associations and other entities around the world have received the invitation.

The invited entities are required to fill in the *Delegation Information Form* before February 1, 2019 to complete the preliminary registration. The team leader shall fill the form separately for each participant, including delegates, observers and faculty advisors, and indicate the name of school, institute or association. The invited entities shall fill in the form in strict accordance with the seat allocation requirement, otherwise they may lose the qualification to participate.

A password is required to open the form, and the exclusive password and country allocation will be sent to the official email address of the invited entity or its responsible person through the Liaisons. If the invited entity has not received any mail or message before January 5, 2019, please send an email directly to inform the Secretariat ([contact@bimun.org.cn](mailto:contact@bimun.org.cn)).

To allow more enthusiastic participants of MUN to join us, the Secretariat of BIMUN 2019 has reserved more than 10 delegations for application.

If your school, institute or association has not been on the invitation list but meets the following conditions, you can apply for the open seats as a new delegation: 1) has been a keen participant of MUN activities for more than three years; 2) has a sound academic atmosphere for MUN. Your school, institute or association can then fill in the *Application for Eligibility Form* and the Secretariat will start the merit-based selection. Applications for the French, Spanish committees and the French and Spanish delegation in the Main Press Centre can be EXEMPT from the requirement 1).

Considering the whole-heart support and kindness from the enthusiasts of various MUN associations, BIMUN will continue to accept the observers with a rolling admission mechanism, namely, first-come-first-serve. However, due to the limited reception capacity of the meeting, the Secretariat will determine the final number of observers based on the overall registration.
